One of the major constraints faced by the people in getting linked to the formal financial system was the strict Know Your Customer (KYC) norms prescribed for opening bank accounts.

To facilitate easy opening of accounts, especially for small customers, the KYC guidelines have been simplified to the extent that these accounts can be opened by way of a self-certification in the presence of bank officials. Further, to leverage upon the UIDAI initiative, RBI has allowed ‘Aadhaar’ to be used as one of the eligible documents for meeting the KYC requirements for opening a bank account.

Very recently, the RBI has also allowed banks to use the E-Aadhaar facility provided by UIDAI for KYC purpose.


The guest speaker was **Miss VANITA PANDEY**.

The event ended with honorarium to the guests and vote of thanks.



Childhood

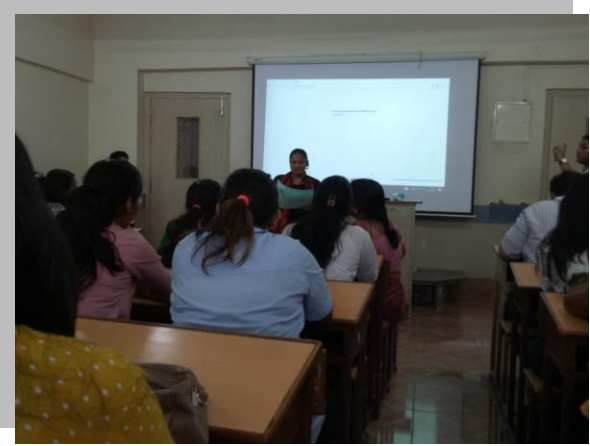
*Childhood was the greatest times of my life ,
